



NSS: keen on Web-to-Print.

The Belgian automation specialist for the graphics industry NSS, based near Bruges, received the Drupa visitors with more than just a dry product demonstration of its Web2Print software suite Vit2Print.

The internal human being was also taken care of. The chocolates were printed with edible ink. More technical details about the print procédé were not given. The chocolate was a realisation of the company Zokola, based near Ypres.



Vit2Print is a modular web-to-print software suite that allows graphic companies and their customers to work interactively on publishing orders. The software can be used as an independent application or integrated with the Digital Asset Management solution of NSS - NSS Production. The main modules of Vit2Print are FormVit (generate ready-for-print PDF based on predefined templates), PuzzleVit (an extension on FormVit for newspaper publishers, to speed up the page layout of advertisements), PhotoVit (digital asset management), CorrectVit (online correction of documents) and TransVit (interactive production of multilingual documents). At the end of last year the system was honoured with a "Master of Excellence" - award in Germany.
